Needs Assessment:

* The school has a room for a science lab but no equipment.

* Grades 9-12 learn from books but have no way to do any hands-on training.

* The community is contributing 52% of the cost of the project (total cost is \$1,395). The Global Uplift Project has committed to raising \$675 (48%).



The Global Uplift Project, in partnership with the Little Sisters Fund, will help equip a room at the Aadarsha Saula Secondary School in Bungamati, to be used for practical science instruction. The school has over 1,800 students in grades 1-12 with 115 dedicated teaching staff. The national science curriculum is taught to students in grades 9-12 but the students cannot compete to go on to higher education because they do not have a lab to learn practical science skills.

The room will be equipped with many different specimens (frogs, butterflies, octopus, leeches), chemicals, and science equipment (microscopes, hydrometer, lactometer, slides, etc.) allowing the teaching of Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
