BACKGROUND OF SCHOOL: Aankura English Secondary Boarding School (AESBS) is one of the schools situated in B.M.P.5 Dolakha with around 400 students. The school was established in 1995 in *Dharamghar* under the founder ship of the Mr. Krishna Bahadur Karki. AESBS School has three building name as AESBS children heaven (primary) block and secondary block at a distance of 50 m from each other. Classes from Pre- nursery to grade 2 are conducted in primary block whereas classes from grade 3 to 10 are conducted in Lower Secondary and secondary block. All the classes from Pre-Nursery to grade 2 are thesaurus in play way method by trained and experienced ladies teacher. Almost all the classes have the capacity to accommodate 50 students but the school administration doesn't keep more than 40 students in one class from grade 3 to 10 but in class nursery to grade3, there are only 30 students in each class. The school has around 27 staff altogether, 22 as a teaching staff and 7 as non-teaching staff. Most of the teachers have the experience of teaching around 10 to 15 years. With the focus on extra – curricular activities the school has various co -curricular teachers of Art, Music, and Dance and as foreign language. The school has its own 3 vehicles which collect the students from different parts of Dolakha Districts. AESBS School has a very diverse student population and allows student multiple opportunities to participate in extracurricular and multicultural activities. The parent's population at the school is extremely supportive of the school culture and takes a vest interest in school events. Beside this, the school has a well-equipped Science laboratory, rich library, and good mathematical lab.

ABOUT THE PROJECT: Recently, school commences the construction of walls for student's convenience. It has the sustainability of today's world and demands. Earth work in excavation, interlocking concrete block paving work for arrangements of students, audiences for better comfortable place.
