**Needs Assessment:**

\* The health center does not have a covered waiting area, so patients have to wait outside, often in extreme conditions

\* The community is contributing over 60% of the cost of the project (total cost is \$4,797). TGUP has committed to raising the other \$1,740.



TGUP, in partnership with the Little Sisters Fund, will build a covered shelter for this health center, which provides a full range of medical services to 9,279 people in Bajrabarahi and the rural area around.

It is open every day for outpatient services, and offers 24-hour emergency treatment. It provides free healthcare to approximately 120 people each day, most of whom are very elderly, or pregnant women and mothers with young children.

Currently patients have to wait outside exposed to extreme weather conditions: it is frequently either very hot and sunny or raining and muddy. These conditions are particularly bad for the elderly who have compromised immune systems, and young children whose bodies cannot yet self regulate for extreme temperatures.
