Needs Assessment:

- The school was built in 1960 and many of the structures have deteriorated and are unsafe
- This one classroom in particular was further damaged by the 2015 earthquake
- The staff and children do not feel safe as the walls and ceiling are cracked and crumbling, and at risk of collapse



TGUP, in partnership with the Nepal Women's Community Service Center (NWCSC), will build a new classroom for the Barahachhetra Secondary School in Rolpa, Nepal. The new classroom will be on the second floor of an existing stable building and be 51'x28' in size.

TGUP previously worked with NWCSC to open a sewing center for TGUP's Girls' Equality Project (GEP) and to provide food support to day workers displaced by Covid-19. NWCSC has a good relationship with the school and has provided GEP kits to the girls.

The school has 593 students in kindergarten to 10th grade. The school offers scholarships to children who cannot afford to go to school and is committed to providing high quality education to all attendees. The school is endorsed by the Ministry of Education. Its curriculum is accredited by the Nepal National Examinations Board.
