Needs Assessment:

- The school was built in 1960 and many of the structures have deteriorated and are unsafe.
- The students, staff and community members do not have access to any clean, safe drinking water and become ill from dirty water.



TGUP, in partnership with the Nepal Women's Community Service Center (NWCSC), will install a water purification system for the Barahachhetra Secondary School in Nepal. The school currently does not have access to any potable water and illness from cholera, dysentery and other water related diseases is common. The system will install a complex water filtration system and reservoir tank that will provide safe drinking water to the 593 students, staff and local community.

TGUP previously worked with NWCSC to open a sewing center for TGUP's Girls' Equality Project (GEP), has provided food support to day workers displaced by Covid-19 and built a new classroom for this same school.

The school offers scholarships to children who cannot afford to go to school and is committed to providing high quality education to all attendees.
