Project Summary:

* The school does not currently have any computers for the students.

* Students could not go on to university studies without computer skills.

* The school and community will contribute 94% of the total cost of the computer lab.



The Global Uplift Project, in partnership with the Little Sisters Fund, will help fund computers for the new computer lab at Bhim Ma Vi government school in Nepal. The school has 188 students and 15 teaching staff but no computers. The school population is comprised of a mix of castes including 'untouchables' (Dalit), Newar, Tamang, and Chhetri.

The computer lab will not only teach computer skills but will also allow for expanded education via the Internet. The computers will attract additional students to the school, so enrollment is expected to increase. The school will provide computer education, after school hours, to people from the local villages.

The school and local community are contributing 94% of the cost of the computer lab, which will include 20 computers, 2 projectors, a smartboard, and an electronic attendance system.

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
