

# **Proposal on Installing Playing Equipment**

## **Bhupu Sainik English Boarding School**

### **Bhotewodaar, Lamjung**



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#### **Introduction:**

Bhupu Sainik English Boarding School is located in northern central part of Nepal in Bhotewodaar, Lamjung. Bhotewodaar lies in Sundarbazar Municipality. As of 2011 Nepal census, it had 11,230 male population and 15,445 female population living in 7,512 households. This area has mixed community including Brahmin, Chhetri, Janajaati and Dalit. Most of the people of this area are engaged in agriculture. They harvest different seasonal crops and sell in the market for the living. Some are also working in private and government offices and some are in abroad gulf country for labor work. The people from Gurung community join British Army, Indian Army and Nepali Army as their main occupation.

Bhupu Sainik English Boarding School was established in 1993 (2050 B.S.). Mr. Resh Bahadur Gurung is the principal of this school. The school runs classes from Nursery to Grade 12. 100% SEE result is achieved by the school till date. 400 students are studying here in Bhupu Sainik School. Among them 230 are girls and 170 are boys. 27 teaching staffs and 3 non-teaching staffs are the backbone of the school as they run the school efficiently and effectively. The school has three concrete buildings where the classes are run and as well as administrative work is also carried on. The school facilitates students by providing library, computer lab and science lab for the intellectual growth of the students.

## School Compound

Beside all these facilities the school is lacking in installing playing equipment for the students. The school have playground for students but lack of playing types of equipment which could be helpful for the students to play during their leisure time. The playing equipment involves students doing more physical activities and maintains their health as they will relieve from the stress. If they are physically and mentally healthy then the future of the students will be bright and they can serve for the nation effectively. So, the school management has requested to install playing equipment for the school.



### Objective:

- To make child friendly school so that students will come to school without any pressure.
- To improve the quality of the school by providing different playing equipment.
- To give the platform for the students to generate their talents and interest in the sports field as well.
- To make school compound attractive and beautiful so that students come daily in the school.
- To minimize absent rate of the students.
