This project will install the computer Braille system at the Sant Gadge Maharaj School School.

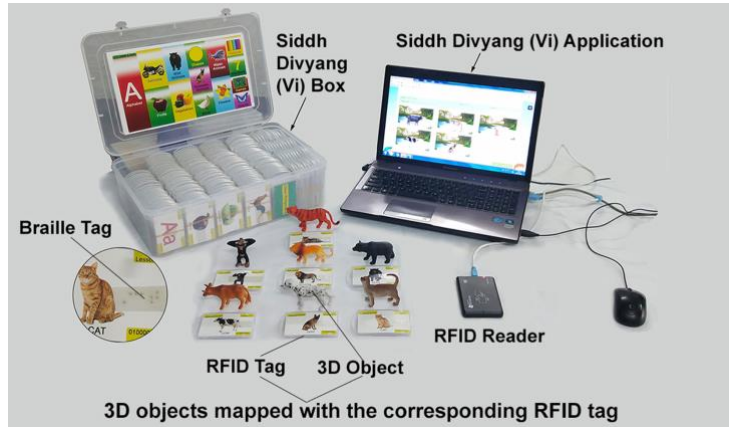
The teachers will be trained on how to use the system. Follow-up on the success of the program will also be conducted.

The teachers will undergo intensive training on the new computer system. There are currently over 500 students who attend the school and 60 visually impaired students in grades 9 and 10.

The teachers, some of whom are visually impaired, will also benefit from the new computer application.
