Introduction

Shree Chunadevi Secondary School is situated in Changu Narayan-6, Nagarkot. Chunadevi is a secondary school where the area has more Brahmin, Tamang and Newar community who are deprived of basic education and awareness. The people of this area primarily engage in agriculture for their livelihood. They cultivate various crops such as rice, maize and vegetables which form the backbone of their sustenance and economic activity. In addition to agriculture animal husbandry is also common, with families raising livestock such as cows, goats and chickens. Tourism is another significance source of income for the community. Local residents often engage in tourism – related activities such as running small shops, guiding tourists and providing lodging and food services. Handicrafts and traditional arts are also important economic activities.



School Area

Shree Chunadevi Secondary School was established in 1988 AD. The current Principal of the school is Ms. Nanu Maiya Giri. There are a total of 205 students and 17 academic staff and 2 non-academic staff member. The school is developing in different fields so that they could provide quality education. The school has two buildings with a library room for the students, infrastructures like desk benches, drinking facilities, and a separate washroom for boys and girls. They are trying their best to improve from their side. School is committed to providing students with a safe and secure environment. We believe that a

well-equipped playground is essential for children’s physical and mental development. However, our current kid's play station lacks proper fencing, which poses a safety risk to our students.

We propose to install fencing around the kid’s play station using iron pipes and a square net. This fencing will:

- Enhance the safety of our students by preventing them from accidentally running out of the play area.
- Deter animals from entering the play station, creating a more hygienic environment.
- Improve the overall aesthetics of the playground.
