East Bali Poverty Project (EBPP) is a nonprofit organization helping the thousands of people in East Bali, Indonesia who are living in abject poverty without water, sanitation, roads, schools, health facilities, or electricity.

EBPP operates a variety of programs to empower local communities to lift themselves out of poverty. They have programs to educate mothers in nutrition to help eliminate malnourished children. They provide education and life skills to children through six hamlet schools, some of which they have built with the help of TGUP.

EBPP provides health outreach programs in maternal and child health including dental care, basic hygiene and sanitation, and first aid training. They promote agroforestry to drive sustainable economic development, teach families to grow their own organic products so they can be self-sustaining, and provide access to clean water and toilets, helping reduce environmental contamination.
