Project Detail:

Eco-Soap Bank will deliver 5,000 bars of soap to TGUP's sewing center in Nyeri, Kenya

Project Partners:

Eco-Soap Bank and Kiini Sustainable Initiative (KISI).

Project Cost:

The total cost is \$2,300 but the Sumar Family Foundation will match all donations, so TGUP's commitment is \$1,150.



Save a Girl is a campaign of TGUP's Girls' Equality Project. GEP provides washable sanitary supplies to adolescent girls in the developing world. The kits cost \$5 to make but are free to the girls. Without such help, the girls cannot manage their period, so they drop out of school. In the worst cases, they are sold as child brides or sex slaves. GEP kits may be one of the most cost-effective liberations of human potential on the planet.

With Covid, it is more important than ever to promote clean hygiene. Eco-Soap Bank rescues quality soap from hotels and manufacturers—diverting it from landfills—so it's completely zero-waste. They then pay women fair wages to transform the leftover soap into clean new bars. Each *Save a Girl* kit will now include one 100gram bar of soap.

The first distribution of kits including soap will go to girls in the Githurai slums in Nairobi. Along with the kits, education will be provided including kit care, reproductive and menstrual health, and self-defense training.
