The Global Uplift Project will provide soccer cleats in assorted sizes for 2 teams at the Githage Secondary School. Currently, the boys play soccer with bare feet and it is very dangerous as the other schools' teams they play against have soccer cleats. 30 pairs will be purchased so that there are enough for everyone on 2 teams to wear a correctly fitting pair of cleats. The competitive team will be able to practice in their cleats without endangering their schoolmates.

We are in the process of doing a complete renovation of the school including building a new classroom, adding electricity, a water catchment system, new latrines and a 4-structure playground. This will complete the conversion of the school into a Model Kenyan School.

The cleats will belong to the school and will not be given to individual students but loaned to them for practice sessions and matches.
