TGUP, in partnership with KISI, will fund the construction of a new classroom for the Githage Secondary Day School. The school has one very old building with 5 rooms for the current enrollment of 118 students. There are many more students that would like to attend but the Ministry of Education has limited enrollment due to the crumbling facilities.

There is limited electricity (only to the staff room) and a small water catchment system. The latrines are also near collapse, so the school is in need of many improvements. This project will include electricity for the new classroom.

The new classroom will consist of stone walls, a poured concrete floor and 5 iron-grate glazed windows. The roof will be made of durable iron sheets. The classroom is expected to provide an education to 1000's of students over its lifetime.

The project will cost \$14,876. Of this, \$1,600 is being contributed by the community, leaving \$13,276 to be funded. This will be the 8th classroom TGUP has built in Kenya.
