Beehives for Kenya

Project Location:

Kirinyaga and Nyeri Counties, Kenya

Project Detail:

Each beehive will be installed at a school, village, farm or in the local forest. Honey will be harvested and sold to support the maintenance of the hives as well as to support school operations and family farming.

Project Partner:

Kiini Sustainable Initiative (Kiini). TGUP has completed many prior projects in partnership with Kiini.

Project Cost:

\$120 per hive



Over $\frac{1}{3}$ of the food that we consume each day relies on pollination, most of which is done by bees. Managed by Kiini, TGUP's longtime partner in Kenya, beehives will be installed for the local schools, villagers, farmers and forest in Kenya.

Everyone that donates a beehive will receive a personalized thank you letter along with a photo of the beehive with a name plaque showing the donor's (or honoree's) name.

The hives will also provide honey. The honey proceeds will be used to supplement school meals, support the hive management and help family farmers. The bees will pollinate the nearby coffee plants on which most people depend for their income. At the nearby test school, where hives were installed last year, the fruits and vegetables in the school kitchen gardens increased 500% and the coffee bushes in the surrounding community almost doubled their yield.
