### HFC Tanzania



Humanity for Children (HFC) is a community-based organization working in remote areas of East Africa.

The organization was formed to identify the major factors that cause death and illness among Maasai mothers and infants, and then create an innovative model to address the problems.

These have included:

- Training traditional birthing attendants (TBAs) on safer birthing practices
- Distributing safe-birthing-kits to TBAs and local clinics
- Installing solar panels on the clinics
- Establishing a basic clinical laboratory at each clinic for the diagnosis of diseases
- Developing a medical transport service using Basic Utility Vehicles
- Distributing malaria preventing bed nets
- Constructing latrines at clinics, schools, and marketplaces
- Training mothers in the “First 1,000 Days” — a child survival initiative

Additionally, micro-loans have given families, and whole villages, the opportunity to improve their standard of living.
