- \* The Kiwanis Family House has been able to meet its mission of helping families in need since 1984 only through the financial and volunteer support of Kiwanis clubs, their members, and through the generosity of the community at large.



The Global Uplift Project, in partnership with the Kiwanis Family House (KFH), funded supplies for the facility including new mattresses, sheets, and pillows. The mission of the KWF is to build a supportive, healing community around families who are impacted by medical emergencies.

The KFH is located in Sacramento, California, and is available to people whose children are being treated by the UC Davis Medical Center. It offers 32 bedrooms, each with shower and bathroom facilities, four kitchens with dining areas for self-meal preparation, a laundry room, a children's game room, and an outdoor play area.

These distraught families, who do not have the financial means to stay near their children, would otherwise be forced to sleep in their cars, with no access to bathing, bathrooms, laundry facilities or a place to gain respite from their overwhelming fears.
