

Partner Profile Kambuja Youth Organization Cambodia





The Kambuja Youth Organization was founded in 2002 to provide a safe place for orphaned or abandoned children to live, be cared for and educated at the local school. The founders were themselves orphaned by the Khmer Rouge and, in a country still reeling from genocide, they opened their own home to endangered children.

Around 40 children are now resident, and hundreds of others have been helped by KYO to finish school and find jobs. Since its founding in Anchagn village, near the world heritage sites of Siem Reap, KYO has used donations to improve and expand the orphanage: digging a well; building hard-wall dormitories; constructing and equipping a language classroom and a computer lab.

KYO hopes to provide help to the local community, for example, by extending a water purification system to take clean drinking water to the local school and village, eliminating the need to buy costly bottled water. <u>Partner Name</u>: Kambuja Youth Organization (KYO)
