The KanjUU School in Ngariama, Kenya had meager facilities. The 140 students and 16 teachers and staff shared five decrepit classrooms. There was no water or electricity. Members and clubs of Kiwanis International Cal-Nev-Ha Region 16 committed to help. With TGUP and KISI in Kenya, we built a new classroom, brought in electricity, installed water collection and a TGUP Science Lab in a Box (SLaB). It's like night and day.



Construction began April 3, 2022. The new classroom is made of cut stone on a concrete foundation. The roof is made of zinc-coated sheet metal. The SLaB allows world class high school laboratory work in Biology, Chemistry, and Physics. Community members contributed 25% of the cost through in-kind labor, helping keep the costs down.

This classroom will stand for more than thirty years and will provide a better education to thousands of Kenyan children. It is proof of TGUP's and Kiwanis' values: that we are bigger when we help others; and we are more powerful when we work together. **Thank you, Region 16 Kiwanis members for showing us that!** You are truly "Serving the Children of the World."
