TGUP, in partnership with KISI, will fund installation of electricity throughout the school. This is one of three projects at the Kanjuu Secondary School.

In addition to the electrical installation, a new 28'x28' classroom will be built. The school currently has 5 classrooms, all in need of repair, for the 140 students. Due to the lack of classroom space, some students take classes outside in a makeshift area.

A science lab will also be outfitted with shelving and locking cupboards in anticipation of one of TGUP's first **Science Lab in a Box (SLaB)** installations. The electrical installation will allow the students to practice lab science and compete for university entrance.

With these improvements, enrollment is expected to increase sharply in the next few years.

This project will cost \$2,314. Of this, \$500 is being contributed by the community, leaving \$1,814 to be funded.
