The new kitchen is part of a larger campaign to renovate the Kiahuko Primary School. Earlier, we brought in water, built latrines, and installed electricity throughout the school. Now, we are building a new classroom, kitchen, and playground.

The old kitchen, seen above, is completely decrepit. The new one will be built of cut stone blocks on a concrete foundation. It will include two modern, commercial cooking vats to cook two meals a day for the school's 487 students.

The new kitchen will measure 30' x 15' and be separated into two rooms: one for cooking, and one to hold supplies. It will have windows with grills on them for proper ventilation and for serving the students. A new 5,000-liter water tank will be installed to provide running water to the kitchen.

It is currently impossible to provide healthy and safe meals to the school's 487 students and 26 staff. The community is contributing \$2,000 in labor and materials to help keep the cost down. We have received another \$2,000 as a matching grant.
