



TGUP Project Summary

Latrines for Kiangi Primary School Mathira, Kenya

Kiini Sustainable Initiative (KISI). TGUP has completed more than two dozen projects in partnership with KISI, including classrooms, latrines, playgrounds, water projects, etc.

Project Cost:

\$6,000

Needs Assessment:

- * There are 220 students and 13 staff who share latrines that are near collapse.
- * Girls often skip school because of the lack of latrines.



TGUP, in partnership with Kiini Sustainable Initiative, will build a block of latrines with 4 stalls at Kiangi Primary School in Mathira, Nyeri county. The structure will contain 2 private stalls for girls, 2 for boys, as well as a separate urinal and a handwashing station. The school currently has 13 teaching staff and 220 students. There are 8 classrooms but 5 have been condemned, so two grades are taught offsite.

Because of the poor condition of the latrines, girls end up having to wait in line to use them, often causing them to be late for class. And there is no place to wash up, so girls skip school altogether, leading to eventual dropout.

This is one of the poorest schools with the most rundown facilities. Even the boys tend to drop out and try to work since most families are peasant farmers that live hand to mouth.

The budget for this project is as follows:
