Kihuyo Secondary School Kitchen Remodel

Nyeri, Kenya

October 4, 2021

The Kihuyo Mixed Day Secondary School has 170 students supported by 10 staff. Enrollment is expected to increase by 50% over the next few years. The old kitchen was falling apart and in such disrepair that it was no longer possible to provide safe, hygienic, and nutritious meals.



This project included a complete refurbishment of the existing kitchen building. On the exterior, this included: replacing the roof, replacing the windows, installing metal grills on the windows, putting in a new steel door, fixing the stucco, and painting. Inside the kitchen: the cooking 'jikos' were repaired and refinished, new chimneys were installed, the old floor was removed and a new cement one laid, the counters were replaced with tile, electricity and new sinks were added.

TGUP worked with its Kenyan partner, Kiini Sustainable Initiative, to build this project. The community contributed 28% (\$1,800) of the total project cost of \$6,334.



TGUP also recently added a new latrine building for this school. In the words of the school principal "We do most sincerely and humbly appreciate your great assistance to our school. You have really assisted in many areas which have greatly motivated our students and teachers and have improved our students' results and now most recently have helped us have a new kitchen which was in a very bad state. The students will now be served faster and have more extra time for studying. The cooks will now work in a very conducive kitchen."
