Needs Assessment:

- * Many families cannot afford masks or soap.
- * These are families supported by our NGO partner, LSF.
- * Most remote areas do not have running water so providing soap is essential for staying healthy.
- * Each family receives multiple masks and bars of soap.



The Global Uplift Project, in partnership with the Little Sisters Fund, helped fund masks and soap for prevention of Covid. Little Sisters Fund helps economically disadvantaged Nepalese girls to become empowered leaders through education, mentoring, and community support. LSF partners with 95 schools in 21 districts in Nepal and supports close to 3,000 girls (Little Sisters).

Their goal is to provide masks and soap to each family with a Little Sister. Each family member received one mask and one bar of soap, and every Little Sister received a second mask. Some families had up to 13 members that received the donation.

Nepal has no national health care so anyone requiring medical attention has to pay upfront. Most families cannot afford doctor visits so these masks and bars of soap could be life-saving.
