## Clusters of Clubs Collaborating to Create Catalytic Change

### La Quebradita School, Nicaragua



In La Quebradita, Nicaragua, 44 students go to school in a shipping container. NorCal Kiwanis Clubs will collaborate to build the community a new school.

#### **FACTS ABOUT THE PROJECT:**

- A 40' shipping container is the only classroom in the village
- We'll build a 20'x 33' classroom, like in La Pitilla, nearby, above right photo
- Concrete foundation, steel frame, and zinc-coated sheet metal roof
- Estimated usable life: 30 years
- Total project cost: \$12,000. Includes 2 sets of new latrines, for boys and girls

#### **FACTS ABOUT THE GLOBAL UPLIFT PROJECT**

- Founded by Palo Alto Kiwanis member, Robert Freeman
- Has built 15 other classrooms in Nicaragua
- Has completed 150 projects overall, in 17 of the world's poorest countries
- 100% of every dollar donated goes to the La Quebradita classroom
- A registered 501c3 nonprofit
