The children in the tiny village of La Quebradita in Nicaragua were going to school in a shipping container. It was too small, too hot, and too narrow for good teaching and learning. Division 44 and Palo Alto and Los Altos clubs came together with TGUP's 6C Program to fund a beautiful new classroom, two new latrines, and a new playground. It's like night and day.



Construction began February 25, 2021. The new classroom is made with a steel frame on a concrete foundation. The walls are concrete-reinforced fiber. The roof is made of zinc-coated sheet metal. Community members contributed 25% of the cost through in-kind labor. Because of that, the whole thing only cost \$13,000.

This classroom will stand for more than thirty years and will help educate thousands of Nicaraguan children. It is proof of TGUP's and Kiwanis' values: that we are bigger when we help others; and we are more powerful when we work together. **Thank you, Kiwanis members for showing us that!** You are truly "Serving the Children of the World."
