Needs Assessment:

- Second and third grades have classrooms with leaking roofs, walls, and floors.
- The conditions are so bad that teaching and attendance is affected.
- Electricity will also be installed as part of this project.



The Las Flores Public Rural School has 106 students and 4 staff teaching in deplorable conditions.

Two groups of children have classrooms that are falling apart: the roof leaks, the wooden walls are full of holes because the planks have shrunk, and the floors have cracks in them. All of this allows for both wind and water to enter the classrooms during the rainy season which lasts 9 months.

Depending on funding, this project will construct either one or two classrooms. Each room will be 20'x26' and be made from concrete bricks, metal roof, and barred windows. The construction will include the installation of electrical wiring and lights.

The community is contributing as much as they can in the form of unskilled labor. TGUP's has previously built more than 15 classrooms with Seeds of Learning, our local partner.
