

# REPORT ON LEGO DISTRIBUTION AND SCHOOL VISITS

This report outlines the recent visits to two schools and the successful distribution of LEGO learning materials, made possible through the generous partnership with the Global Uplift Project. The initiative aimed to support inclusive learning, enhance developmental skills, and bring joy to children in underserved and special needs environments.

### 1. Government-Owned Special School

The first visit was to a government-run special school that serves learners aged 3 to 29 years. The institution provides both literacy education and practical skills development, including tailoring, gardening, and writing skills. This approach equips learners with tools for independence and productivity.

The LEGO donation was allocated to a class of 20 learners with Autism and ADHD. The Headteacher emphasized that such learning materials are essential for improving attention span, developing fine motor skills, and enhancing cognitive engagement through structured play.

The school expressed deep gratitude and highlighted the ongoing need for more educational toys and sensory-support tools. They also welcomed the possibility of continued partnerships to strengthen support for learners with special needs.

### 2. Community School for Children with Special Needs and Vulnerable Backgrounds

The second visit was to a community school founded by a mother whose child developed a disability after being wrongly diagnosed and treated. Facing stigma and limited support, she left her job to care for her child.

Her personal journey led to the creation of a school dedicated to supporting children with attention deficit disorders and those from vulnerable backgrounds. The institution provides a nurturing and inclusive environment where children can learn and thrive.

The LEGO donation was received with heartfelt gratitude. The school owner expressed appreciation to the Global Uplift Project and shared hope for continued collaboration in the future.
