In Luz de Cristo, Nicaragua, 45 students go to school on the porch of a building. CalNevHa **Division 12 Clubs** will collaborate to build the community a new school.

FACTS ABOUT THE PROJECT:

- We'll build a 20'x 33' classroom, like the one above, right, we built for Div 44
- Concrete foundation, steel frame, and zinc-coated sheet metal roof
- Community members will contribute 20% of the cost through in-kind labor
- Estimated usable life: 30 years
- Project cost: \$15,000; San Jose Club has committed \$1,500
- A \$3,000 matching grant has been secured, so \$10,500 is still needed

FACTS ABOUT THE GLOBAL UPLIFT PROJECT

- Founded by 13-year Palo Alto Kiwanis member, Robert Freeman
- Has built 17 other classrooms in Nicaragua
- Has completed 174 projects overall, in 18 of the world's poorest countries
- **100% of every dollar donated** goes to the Luz de Cristo classroom
- TGUP is a registered 501c3 nonprofit
