Needs Assessment:

- The existing school does not have any electricity.
- On cloudy days, the classroom can be very dark, making it hard to read.
- Electricity will allow the classroom to be used by the community after school hours.



The Global Uplift Project, in partnership with Seeds of Learning, will install electric lighting to both the existing classroom and the new 33'x20' classroom we are building for the community of Luz de Cristo.

Solar panels will be installed to provide the power to run the lights. The community has committed to contributing labor to help keep the costs low.

Having electric lights in both buildings will enable the students and teachers to be able to read and write, even on cloudy days. Currently, they cannot do either during early morning classes on cloudy days.

Once the electricity is installed, the villagers will be able to use the school rooms in the evenings to house community events, adult education and health services.

All of the projects have the endorsement of the Ministry of Education.
