TGUP, in partnership with Kiini Sustainable Initiative, will construct a new building containing 4 pit latrines and one urinal at the Mwiyogo Primary School. Currently, there are 12 teachers/staff and 327 students: 170 girls and 157 boys. These latrines will be used by both boys, girls, and the staff.

The existing latrines have collapsed, and the Ministry of Health has condemned them as unusable and unsafe. This is an emergency situation for the school and students, as it is at risk of being shut down due to the lack of latrines.

This project will construct a new building containing 4 stalls with pit latrines and one urinal. These latrines will be shared by the entire school. Next year, it is TGUP's hope to build a separate building just for girls, at which time this building will be dedicated for boys only.

The budget for this project is as follows:
