Nsawo Community Development Project (NCDP) is a registered nonprofit community-based organization located in the Luweero District in the Central Region of Uganda, just north of Kampala. The Luweero District [was the site of a fierce insurgency by the rebel group National Resistance Army and a brutal counter-insurgency by the government of Milton Obote, known as the Luweero War or the “Bush War”, that left many thousands of civilians dead during the early to mid-1980s](#)¹. Many others were left in abject poverty.

Partnering with TGUP, NCDP has opened a sewing center to produce and distribute TGUP’s *Save a Girl* kits. Medical staff from the neighboring clinic attend kit distributions to help give the menstrual hygiene education, and to check on the health of the students. NCDP is also undertaking larger infrastructure projects including building new classrooms, latrines, installing electricity to schools, etc.

NCDP provides support to schools with underserved students; they provide nutritious ingredients for school lunches, hygiene kits for school children, “Shoes that Grow” for students who don’t have shoes, and basic school supplies such as pens, pencils, rulers, and notebooks.
