Needs Assessment:

- One of the current classroom buildings is falling down and has been condemned.
- There are 895 students in 7 rooms.
- This new classroom will be for the 76 students in grade 5.
- The community and NGO partner are contributing \$1,764 towards the project.



Working with Action For Change, TGUP will help fund the construction of a new 24' x 21' classroom for the Ndongo Community School in Buea, Cameroon.

The school has 7 classrooms, 7 teachers and 12 grades with a total of 895 students. All of the classrooms have dirt floors, holes in the wood plank walls, and leaking roofs.

95% come from families who make their living as peasant farmers, living off the land. Despite the poor conditions, the community and NGO will contribute their time and work to help offset the labor costs.

The new classroom will be made from cement blocks with a solid cement foundation. There will be 4 ventilation windows in the room as well as a locking iron door. The new room will be for use of the 76 students in grade 5.
