Needs Assessment:

- The 7 classrooms hold 895 children.
- Many sit on the dirt floor due to lack of benches and chairs.
- Students lack the basic supplies (pencils, notebooks, etc.)
- 95% live below the UN poverty level.



Working with Action For Change, TGUP will help fund 15 new benches, 2 tables, 4 chairs, and misc school supplies for the 895 students at the Ndongo Community Primary School. 90% of children (mostly orphans, girls, and internally displaced children) don't have basic school items, such as textbooks, exercise books, pens, pencils, rulers, sharpeners, erasers, etc.).

The school only has 5 classrooms and 7 teachers for the 895 students. All of the classrooms have dirt floors, holes in the wood plank walls, and leaking roofs.

95% come from families who make their living as peasant farmers, living off the land. Providing for these basic supplies will reduce fighting and scrambling for seating position and increase school attendance.

Action For Change is helping cover 25% of the total cost of this project.
