Project Summary:

- Seamstresses from the existing TGUP sewing center will train women in the new centers.
- More than 200 women will be trained within the first 3 months.
- 8 sewing machines and 4 sergers will be provided.



TGUP started a *Save a Girl* sewing center in Dang, 3 years ago, with 3 machines and 1 serger. They grew, on their own, to have 19 machines and more than 40 trained seamstresses. In addition to sewing *Save a Girl* kits, they have made more than 150,000 COVID masks and distributed them to health care providers and the poor.

Because of their success, they have decided to spin off 4 satellite centers so they can train and empower even more women and help even more girls.

Each of the new centers had 2 sewing machines that were used for training. An experienced seamstress from the Dang center has been assigned to each of the new centers and will train 50 new seamstresses over the next 3 months. This project provided 2 sewing machines and 1 serger for each new new sewing centers.
