Latrines for girls at the Ngungu Secondary School, Kirinyaga

Needs Assessment:

- The girls' toilets are collapsing and pose serious health risks.
- This project will provide safe and hygienic toilets that will enable girls to stay in school, particularly during menstruation.
- ODFL previously built latrines for staff and the boys. This will give girls comparable facilities, providing dignity and health.



ODFL, in partnership with Kiini, will fund the construction of 4 pit latrines for the girls at the Ngungu Secondary School in Kirinyaga, Kenya. The existing toilets are in a deplorable condition causing many girls to skip school, especially during their periods.

ODFL previously funded toilets for staff and the boys. Now it is finally time for the girls to have their own dedicated toilets. In the summer of 2019, ODFL sent 11 students to the Ngungu school to help build a classroom. The American students were shocked at the condition of the girls' toilets and promised to do something about it.

The school and community have committed to covering \$2000 of the project cost by volunteering labor and raising funds to help keep the overall project cost low. This will be the sixth project that ODFL has supported at the Ngungu School. In addition to the classroom and prior latrines, ODFL has funded a water catchment system, and desks.
