Needs Assessment:

* The school has a courtyard where the children play but no equipment.

* The project will provide 7 different playground options.

* Children perform better in school when allowed to play.

* The community is contributing 50% of the cost of the project (total cost is \$7,226). TGUP has committed to raising the other \$3,613.



TGUP, in partnership with the Little Sisters Fund, will install a playground for the Pawan Secondary School. The school has been supported by Little Sisters Fund for over 10 years.

The school has more than 1,200 students, 95% of whom are from economically disadvantaged families belonging to the *Madhesi* or *Dalit* groups (untouchables).

The school has a dirt courtyard where the children play but there is currently no playground equipment. This project will include a basketball court, volleyball court, slides, swings, merry-go-rounds, seesaws, etc.

TGUP had previously installed 12 cement benches around the courtyard area. The students have never had access to any play equipment. The community and school are contributing 50% of the cost of the project and are very supportive and excited.
