A Brief History about Royal Seeds Nursery primary school

Royal seed primary school is a community primary school that is found in mile 14 –Dibanda, South West Region of Cameroon. The school is being attended by very poor village children aged 4-13 years, many of whom are orphans, girls and internally displaced children. Indeed, the establishment of the school six (06) years ago has facilitated school attendance for school going age children especially the very poor and internally displaced children. A total of 262 poor, needy and internally displaced children attend Royal Seed primary school of which there are 148 girls and 114 boys based on the head teacher. The school is managed by Parent Teachers Association who are struggling to raise funds to pay seven (07) teachers of the school and to provide other basic needs of the school.

The absence of safe drinking water at Royal Seeds primary school is affecting the teaching learning process negatively, as children sometimes abandon lessons in search of the precious liquid, water some 2km away from the school. Children end up drinking contaminated water used by domestic animals around the school campus. The poor hygiene and sanitation and lack of potable water in school have often resulted in water related diseases like cholera and diarrhea. From our need assessment, there is the possibility of extending safe drinking water to the school as a water scheme already exists which is situated about 2 km from the school.

NB: A gender sensitive toilet at Royal seeds primary school will enhance hygienic and sanitation at Royal seeds primary school as kids will no longer defecate in nearby bushes around the school environment. Also, with safe drinking water on Campus children will not abandoned lessons in search of the precious liquid some kilometers away from the school. Kids will be able to wash their hands after using the toilet, thus enhancing hygiene and sanitation properly in the school environment

What will be done

We will extend safe drinking water into the school from the water catchment which exist approximately 2km away from the school. We will build and tiles the entire tap with two running taps to self the school community and the surrounding environment.
