### A Brief History about ROSA primary school mile 16 Bolifamba

ROSA community primary school is found in Bolifamba village community. The school is being attended by very poor village children aged 4-12 years, many of whom are orphans, girls and internally displaced children. Indeed, the establishment of the school has facilitated school attendance for school going age children who had no access before and/or who used to walk long distances to attend school, especially the less privileged children. A total of 254 pupils attend ROSA community primary school of which 132 are girls and 122 boys based on the head teacher and our need assessment. The school is managed by the poor peasant community who are doing their best to ensure their children have access to education by struggling to raise funds to pay six (6) teachers employed to teach in the school. The poor peasant community is unable to raise enough funds to construct modern pit toilet and provide safe drinking water

in the school for poor and needy children attending the school. This is affecting the teaching learning process negatively.

The absence of safe drinking water in ROSA community primary school has made matters worse as children abandon lessons in search of the precious liquid water some 2km away from the school. This is affecting the teaching learning process in ROSA community primary school negatively. Children end up drinking contaminated water used by domestic animals around the school campus. The poor hygiene and sanitation and lack of potable water in school have often resulted in water related diseases like cholera and diarrhea. In March 2024, two cases of cholera and so many cases of diarrhea were confirmed among kids attending ROSA community primary school based on statistics from a local dispensary in the community and our discussion with the head teacher of the school. From our need assessment, there is the possibility of extending safe drinking water to the school as a water scheme already exists which is situated about 2km from the school.

## **What will be done**

We will extend safe drinking water into the school from the water catchment which exist approximately 2km away from the school. We will build and tiles the entire tap with two running taps to self the school community and the surrounding environment.
