## A Brief History about Royal Seeds community primary school

Royal seed primary school is a community primary school that is found in mile 14 –Dibanda, South West Region of Cameroon. The school is being attended by very poor village children aged 4-13 years, many of whom are orphans, girls and internally displaced children. Indeed, the establishment of the school six (06) years ago has facilitated school attendance for school going age children especially the very poor and internally displaced children. A total of 262 poor, needy and internally displaced children attend Royal Seed primary school of which there are 148 girls and 114 boys based on the head teacher. The school is managed by Parent Teachers Association who are struggling to raise funds to pay seven (07) teachers of the school and to provide other basic needs of the school.

The situation of inadequate classroom furniture (desks, tables & chairs) at Royal Seed community primary school has caused many children to stay away from classes, making learning ineffective as it discourages weaker and younger scholars from coming to school since there is always fighting and scrambling for seating positions amongst younger and older scholars. It is common to see many children crowding on a single desks, with some seated on the floor or stones. An average of 5-6 children seats on a desk. Children staying at home without going to school because of lack of classroom furniture's (desks, tables & chairs) will only increase poverty in the long run in a community dominated by poor and needy people.
