## A Brief History about Royal Seeds Nursery primary school

Royal seed primary school is a community primary school that is found in mile 14 –Dibanda, South West Region of Cameroon. The school is being attended by very poor village children aged 4-13 years, many of whom are orphans, girls and internally displaced children. Indeed, the establishment of the school six (06) years ago has facilitated school attendance for school going age children especially the very poor and internally displaced children. A total of 262 poor, needy and internally displaced children attend Royal Seed primary school of which there are 148 girls and 114 boys based on the head teacher. The school is managed by Parent Teachers Association who are struggling to raise funds to pay seven (07) teachers of the school and to provide other basic needs of the school.

The absence of toilet facility at Royal Seeds community primary school has compelled many pupils to defecate in nearby farms, streams and pavements. It is common to see children practicing open defecation around the school environment especially the younger scholars. The presence toilet facility is full and kids have been restricted from using the toilet facility especially the younger scholars as they end up stepping on feces. This has made the school environment not too conducive for teaching learning process due to bad odour from the school environment.
