WHAT IS SAVE A GIRL™?

- **Save a Girl™** is a washable, reusable sanitary kit that helps girls manage their period so they can stay in school. More than 90,000 kits have been distributed.
- A kit costs \$6 to make and lasts for three years. They are given free of charge to girls in 11 developing world nations.

WHY IS SAVE A GIRL™ IMPORTANT?

- More than 20,000,000 girls drop out of school every year because they cannot manage their period. It might be as many as 50,000,000.
- This is why in much of the world females are second class citizens; they have less education than boys.
- But this is *entirely preventable*.

HOW ARE SaG KITS MADE AND DISTRIBUTED?

- Kits are made at [TGUP Save a Girl™ sewing centers](#) in 5 developing world countries: Kenya; Tanzania; Uganda; Cameroon; and Nepal.
- The centers employ local seamstresses in high-paying, meaningful work earning 40% above the national average wage.
