Project Summary:

Purchase a vehicle for our Kenyan partners to deliver kits and transport presenters.

Project Detail:

Our Kenyan partners have made and distributed over 20,000 sanitary kits. Distributions will be more efficient with their own delivery vehicle.

Project Partner:

Kiini Sustainable Initiative (KISI). TGUP has completed more than two dozen projects in Central Kenya since 2009.

Project Cost:

\$7,800



The Global Uplift Project funded the car shown above so that our partners can more easily deliver *Save a Girl* kits to the remote parts of the six counties in which we distribute: Nyeri, Kirinyaga, Muranga, Kiambu, Laikipia and Nairobi.

Kit distributions vary in size from just a few at each location to more than a thousand. For the large distributions, not only do the kits need to be transported, but several presenters also need to get to the location to give the education part of the distribution.

When it is not needed for kit distributions, the car will be used for site visits to current and potential project locations, as well as to inspect past projects, including the beehives that are at multiple locations.
