Classroom and Latrine San Antonio, Nicaragua

San Antonio School

Project Location:

San Antonio, located 18 miles from Tipitapa

NGO Partner:

Seeds of Learning

Project Cost:

\$14,358

Needs Assessment:

- The nearest school has become too dangerous to access.
- The existing facility made from sticks has collapsed.
- The classroom will be used by the community after school hours.
- A new latrine will also be installed as none currently exists.



TGUP, in partnership with Seeds of Learning, will fund the construction of a new 33'x20' one-room school and latrine for the community of San Antonio.

Students in the community used to go to a school located 1.5 miles away in the neighboring village of Santa Martha. But a high-speed road was recently installed, making it too dangerous for the small children to cross. Only 3 out of 32 students are making the trip to go to school. So, volunteers of the community started to teach the children in private homes. Later a small room made of sticks was built to host the students, but it was unstable and collapsed. Children are now without access to any education.

The community has committed to contributing labor and quarry materials to level the land prior to construction. A new latrine will also be constructed for the students and teacher. After school, the classroom will be used for community events, education, and health services.
