TGUP, in partnership with KISI, will fund the installation of electricity to 14 classrooms and offices for the Shining Star primary school in rural Nyeri county. On cloudy days and/or early in the mornings, there is insufficient light for the students and staff to read.

The main electrical cable is already installed on the nearby road. The installation will include running wiring from the road and hanging light fixtures in each classroom and office. The main circuit breaker switch will be placed in the office. More than 1,100 feet of cable and more than two dozen outlets will be hooked up.

The student population had risen to 450 but due to lack of adequate facilities, in particular classrooms and latrines as required by the Ministry of Education and Public Health, the student population has been reduced to 250. TGUP has recently finished the construction of a new classroom and installed a playground to improve. A latrines project is also scheduled to be funded in the near future to address the expected increased enrollment.
