New classroom for the Shree Ratri Primary School

Project Cost:

\$6,521 with community providing 20%.

Needs Assessment:

- The school was built in 1976 and many of the structures are unstable after the 2015 earthquake.
- The students and staff do not feel safe in the existing buildings, which contributes to low enrollment.



TGUP, in partnership with the Nepal Women's Community Service Center (NWCSC), will construct a 17' x 18' classroom that will be built as an extension to an existing building. The addition will be made with brick walls, a cement floor, and flat plaster roof. The room will have 4 windows and one door.

TGUP has previously had very successful projects working with NWCSC, including opening a sewing center for TGUP's *Save a Girl* program, providing food support to day workers displaced by Covid-19, and building a new classroom and water purification system for a different school.

The community is contributing 20% of the total cost of the project and is expecting enrollment to increase 30-40% after the new classroom is completed. The school currently has 60 students and 5 dedicated staff members.
