What We Do:

- Build low-cost, high-impact educational infrastructure projects in developing countries
 - Classrooms; medical clinics; science labs; libraries; playgrounds, etc.
 - Help Rotary Clubs realize their aspirations to do work in the developing world



Accomplishments to Date:

- 680+ projects completed in 26 countries in Africa, Asia, and Latin America
 - These projects will help 5+ million of the poorest people in the world have just a slightly better chance in life.



Funding Model:

- Pocket Change
 - Most projects completed from members' donations of \$20, or less.

Special Note:

- *100% of every dollar donated by a club or an individual goes into the donor's intended project. TGUP is a 501c3 non-profit.*
