#### **Project Name:**

Tanzanian New *Save a Girl* Sewing Center

#### **Project Location:**

Loibor-Siret, Tanzania

#### **Project Summary:**

Build a new 30'x30' building to house the *Save a Girl* sewing center.

#### **Project Need:**

- The existing location is too small to accommodate all the machines and seamstresses needed for expanded *Save a Girl* kit production.
- The building will allow for a storefront where the sewing center can sell the items they make.

#### **Project Cost:**

\$12,980



Working with Humanity for Children, TGUP trained seamstresses in Loibor-Siret, Tanzania to make TGUP's *Save a Girl* kits of washable, reusable sanitary supplies. This project will now fund the construction of a new building to house the new, permanent sewing center.

The 30' x 30' building will contain a large room for the sewing center. There will also be three storefronts where women-led businesses can sell their goods and services. It is expected that one will be a hair cutting salon, one will offer veterinary medicines and supplies, and one will sell the goods that the seamstresses make. This will allow the sewing center to be self-sustaining and not rely solely on the funding of *Save a Girl* kits.

The property has been granted to Humanity for Children by the Village Council and the Women's Work Collective, dramatically reducing the cost.
